The courses described in Addendum A have changed for the ILCA 4 Class. Please refer to the new courses attached to this notice.







### SI 14. FINISH

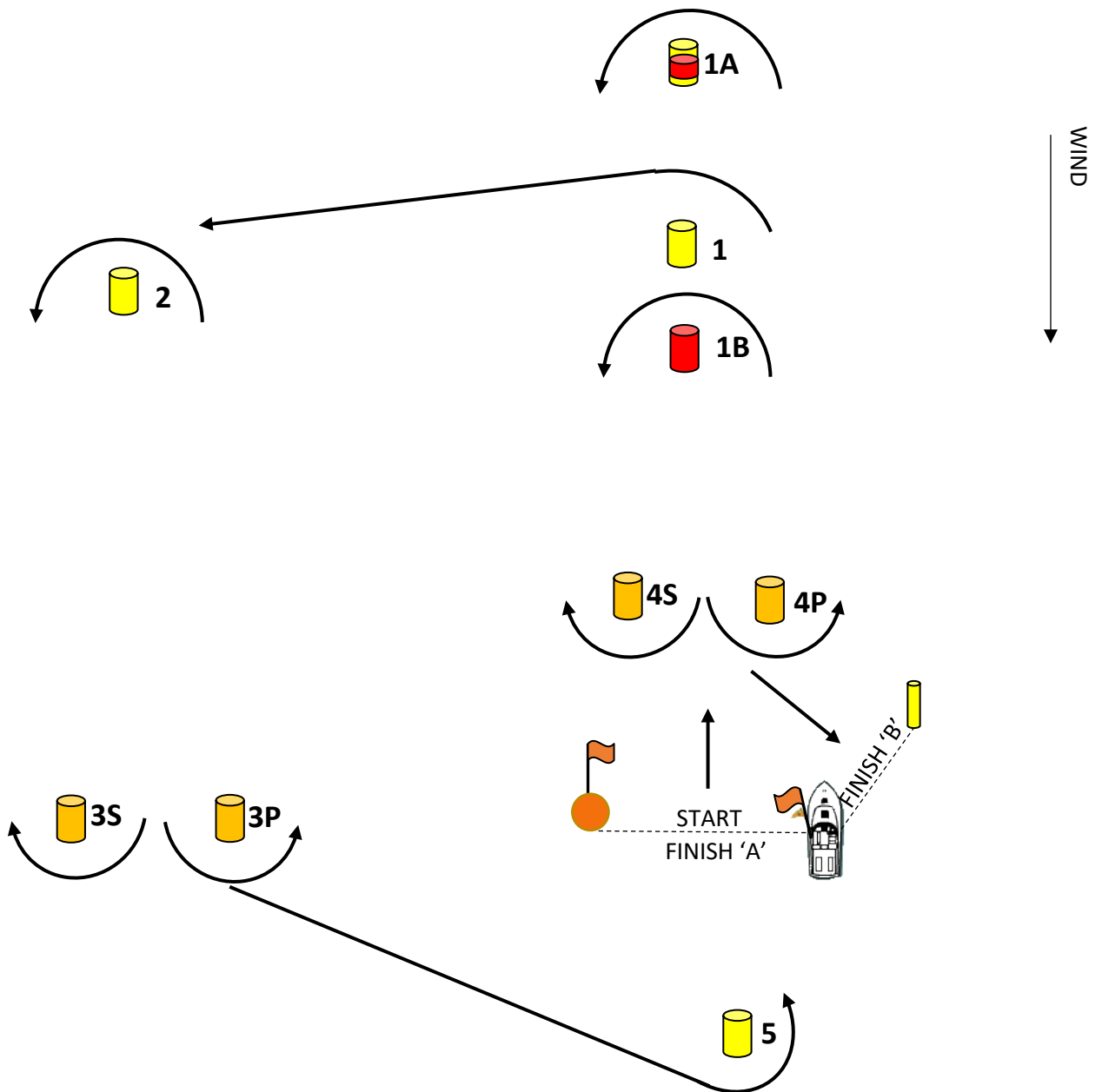
- 14.1 The finishing line is between a staff displaying a blue flag on the Race Committee vessel on the starboard end and the course side of the port end finishing mark.
- 14.2 505 Class will use finishing line 'B' as marked on Addendum A Courses.
- 14.3 ILCA 6 & 7 Classes will use finishing line 'A' as marked on Addendum A Courses.
- 14.4 **ILCA 4 Class will use finishing line 'B' as marked on Addendum A Courses.**
